mation is on our web site.

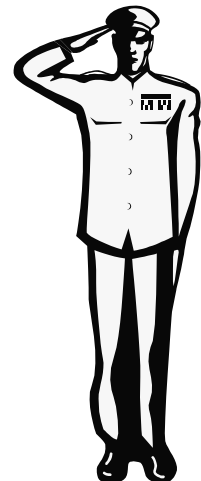
This is my final report to you as your Vice Commodore and I look forward to working with all you as our Commodore in 2006. See you all at the awards dinner.

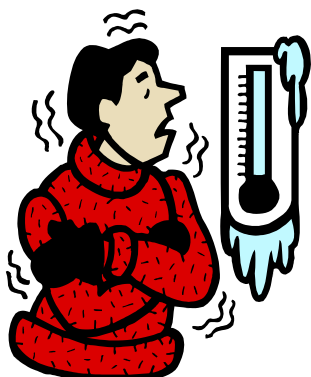
