



Rear Commodore's Report—Mike Haistings



For all of you who have experienced Don and Carol's Clam Linguini, he has relented to share with us his mastery at the culinary art of clam linguini making. This is especially informative because it makes for a great dock meal, i.e. you can make it ahead of time.

Don and Carol's Fabulous **CLAM LINGUINI**

1/2 cube butter

6 cloves fresh garlic

1 tablespoon oregano

1 cup white wine

5 cans (small) of clams (keep liquid from one can)

1/2 teaspoon salt

1/2 teaspoon pepper

2 tablespoons parsley

1 tablespoon basil

1/2 teaspoon ground thyme

1/4 teaspoon hot pepper flakes

7 shakes of cayenne pepper or less according to you taste

11 Roma tomato's (cut into 3/4 inch bites)

Saute in fry pan: Butter and garlic

After saute, add oregano, wine, salt, pepper, parsley, basil, pepper flakes, cayenne, thyme, tomato's & clam necter. Bring to boil and then turn down and simmer till spices blend. 10 minutes before you want to eat add the clams or give enough time for the clams to get hot. I use fresh pasta from the store or make my own.




