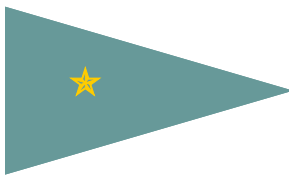
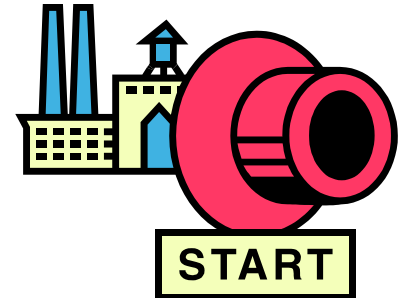

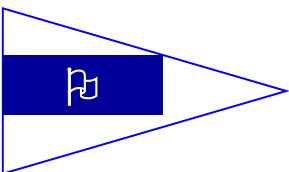

Lopez)

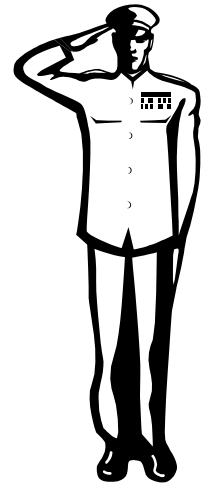
- December 4 Special Peoples cruise
