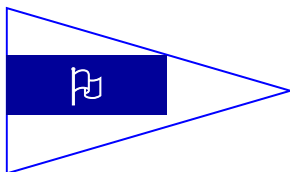


Rear Commodore's Report—Mike Haistings

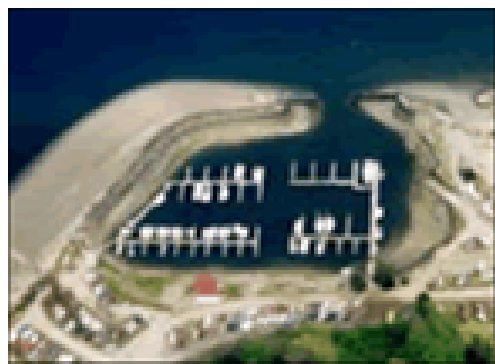
Fleet Captain's Report - Bill Dils

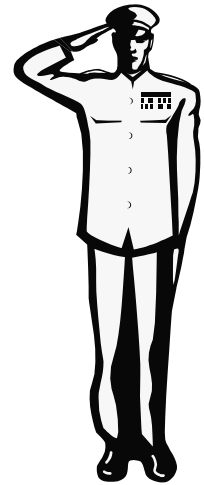

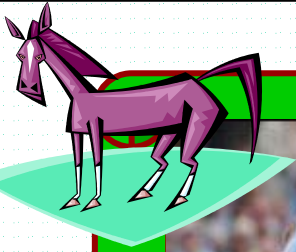

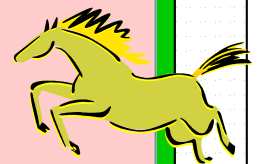
