Speaking of planning the long range planning committee has been meeting to continue our five-year plan. The fa-


cilities sub committee led by Kevin Carlson as almost finished their input. This committee produces a valuable tool as we start the budget process for 2006 and future years.

Rear Commodore's Report—Mike Haistings


