### Vice Commodore's Report - Mike Haistings

December is now upon us and this will be my last very busy year around the club - inside and out; quite a few of our much needed projects got done, some were planned and others an unexpected surprise. A brief look back on 2006: it started with the gas heater failing, given it was 34 years old, it definitely needed to be replaced. We now have a new Lennox high efficiency gas furnace which comes with a 10 year parts and labor warranty and a 20 year limited heat exchanger warranty. We are set for a while with this one! Then next up was the water leak under the side walk along side the building. After digging it up we found that the old galvanize pipe which is the supply line from the street to the club was completely rusted thru and beyond repair. A new 1" wirsbo water supply line was installed from the street to the club, and a new copper line was installed inside the club and run back to the water heater. The copper line has a one year warranty and the wirsbo supply line has a 25 year warranty. And on to a few of the planned proiects, we were in great need of focusing on the exterior of our club house. The old leaky gutter's were removed, and while we had the gutters off, the build-

ing was pressure washed, all repairs to the siding & sound waves article as your vice commodore. It was a cracks were taken care of, and the building received a new coat of paint before the new gutters were installed. And for the finishing touches we had the awning over the front doors cleaned and resealed. I am currently working on replacing all the old dock electrical stations. New stations have been purchased and an electrical contractor has been hired to installed them. If all go's well this project should be completed before the end of the year, or soon there after. I feel pretty good that I am turning over the club facilities to the incoming vice commodore in good order. I would like to thank the bridge, board, and all of our membership for your support with all these projects. In addition I would like to personally thank Pat Hansen for her leadership in managing the club rentals and updating the club calendar; Bill Dils for all his work as our dock master; Kevin Carlson for his focus as facilities committee chair: and Norm Grossman as our Outstation Representative. As I move out of the Vice Commodore role I want to thank every one who showed up to help during the work party's and pinched in throughout the year I couldn't have done it with out all the help.
