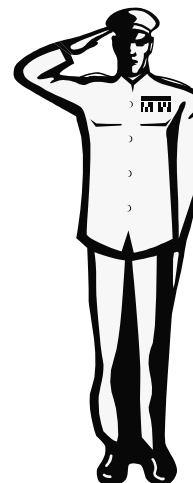

meeting. Let me know which one interests you and I'll sign you on for our 2006 Cruise Season.



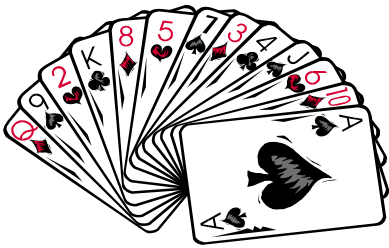
