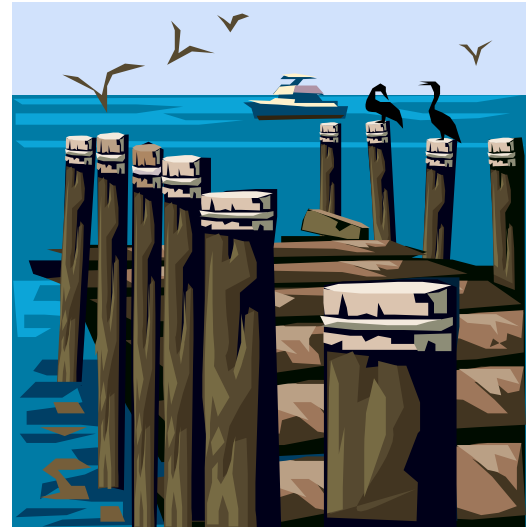

Vice Commodore's Report - Mike Haistings

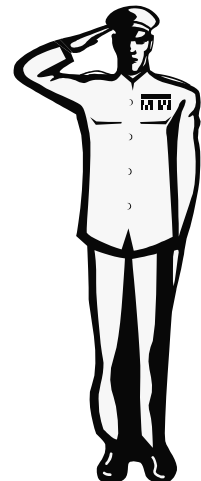

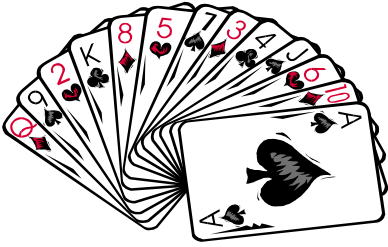

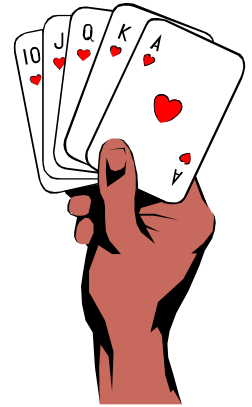
