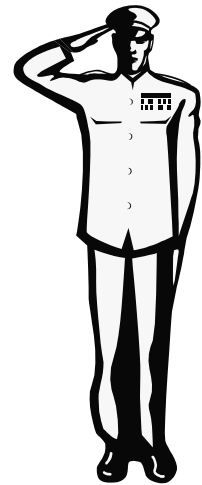

Rear Commodore's Report—Gary Sheneman

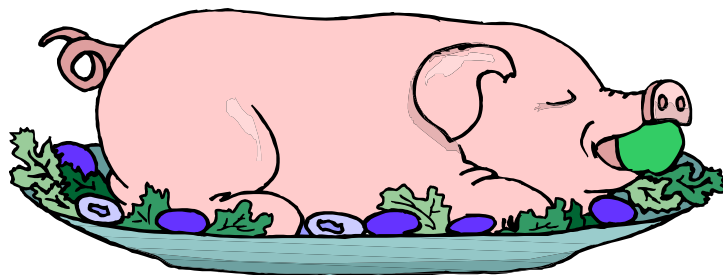
