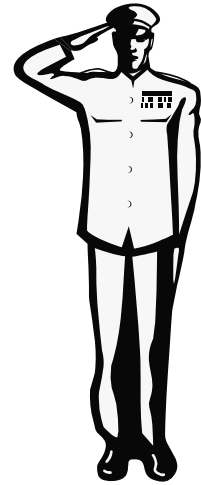

## Fleet Captain's Report - Chris Thomsen

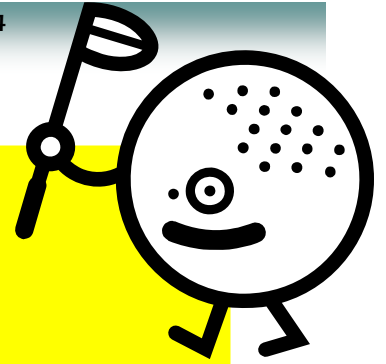
