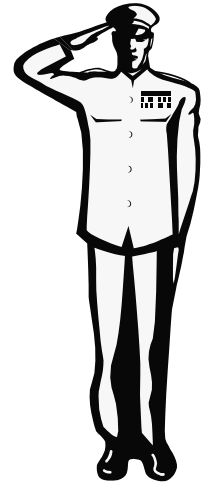

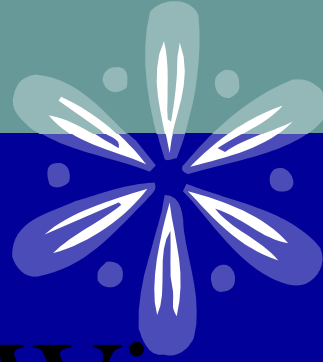
It looks like more great weather right on into the Fall. Wonderful time to own a boat!

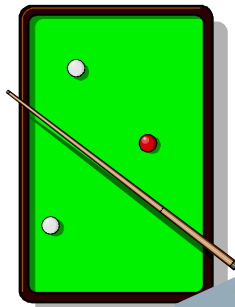

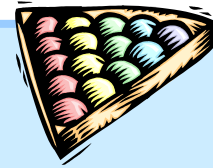
