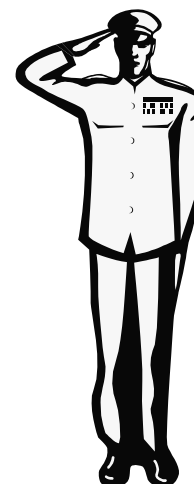

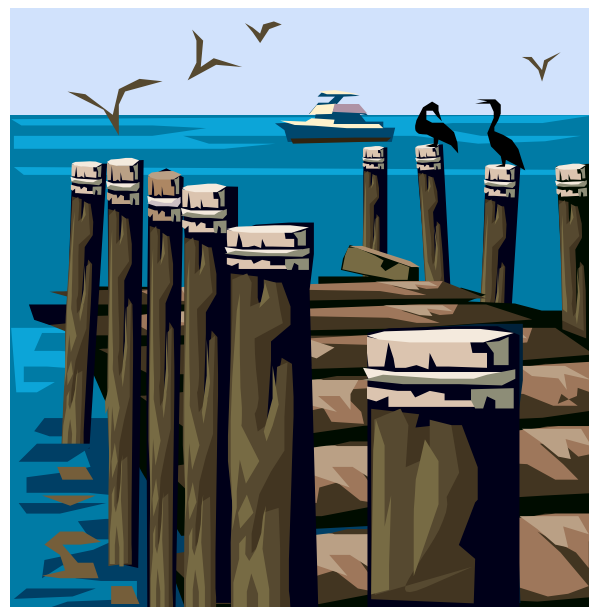
Vice Commodore's Report - Gary Sheneman

Fleet Captain's Report - Chris Kullmann

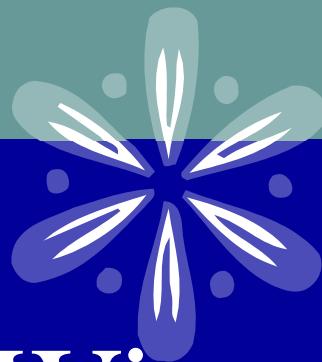
