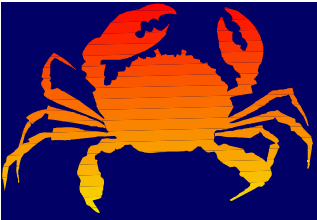

Saturday: Sumptuous Brunch

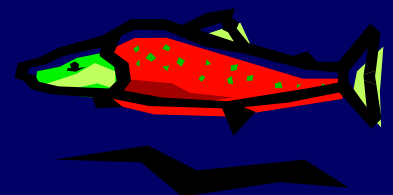
