



## Commodore's Report – Garry Moore

We are enjoying unusually great weather for this time of year. I hope everyone is getting a chance to get out on the water and enjoy great boating. If you are in town over the Fourth you need to get to the Club for "Dock Saturday" to enjoy the festivities Paul and Trina have planned and of course the fireworks at Gasworks Park. The Club is the best spot on the Lake to see the show.

### Hat Island:

There are still some small issues continuing back and forth, but we are pushing to get the agreement resolved soon. One issue that has come up is switching one of our current slips to Slip #9 due to silt building up at the entrance that is forcing the ferry to run over and into our current slip. We need to be sure that Slip 9 has enough width to accommodate our larger boats. A meeting is scheduled for Friday, June 26<sup>th</sup> to hash out the remaining issues.

### Dock Expansion:

We thought we had tentative approval from all agencies for our dock extension, but DNR wants to

have additional staff review the application. We hope to have a final decision by the end of the month. The next steps are the completion of the plans for the building permit and the application to the City. The permit process is taking 3 to 4 months with all of the construction in the City. Regulations don't allow construction in the Lake until October. With the time required for the permitting process, financing and bidding, we are unlikely to be ready to start in October. Realistically we are looking at next fall to start construction.

### RBAW:

The Coast Guard is proposing to replace traditional physical navigation aids such as buoys, beacons and lighthouses with an AIS-integrated electronic navigation display that will appear on electronic charts. The system is called AIS ATON. This will have a serious impact on recreational boaters who don't have access to electronic charts or if their charts are not current or if they don't have access to an AIS signal. ## Fleet Captain's Report – Robert Murphy

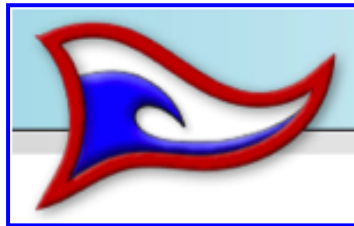
