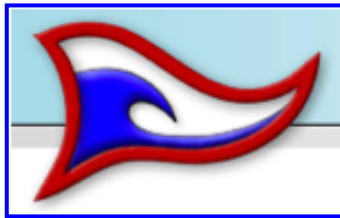
Given we do not have any speakers scheduled in November, feel free to send me any ideas for topics and presenters you would like to see at the next meeting.
