By-law Change: As more and more of our members spend their summers on the water it has become more difficult to have a quorum (20% of the total eligible voting members) for our Board meetings in July. We have had to cancel the July Board Meeting for the last two years. The Regular Meetings in July have also been very lightly attended. The Board has approved a change in our by-laws to eliminate the July Board Meeting and the Regular Meeting in July. The By-laws require a formal notice to the Membership at least 10 days prior to the Regular Meeting preceding the next Regular Meeting at which a vote of the membership is held. The By-laws may be amended by a two-thirds vote of the members representing a quorum being present at the Regular Meeting. The proposed by-law change to be voted on at the November Regular Meeting shall be as follows:

ARTICLE VI
Section 2.00 Regular Meetings
*A Regular meeting for the purpose of conducting Club business and entertainment of the membership shall be held on the third (3rd) Wednesday of each month, (except **July and August**).*

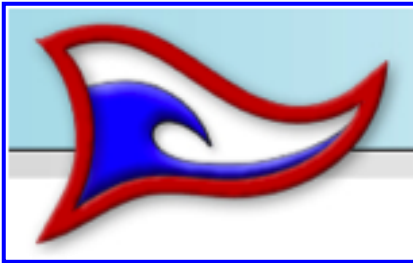

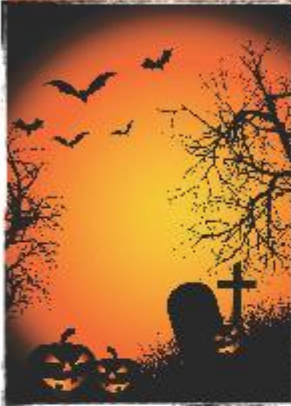
