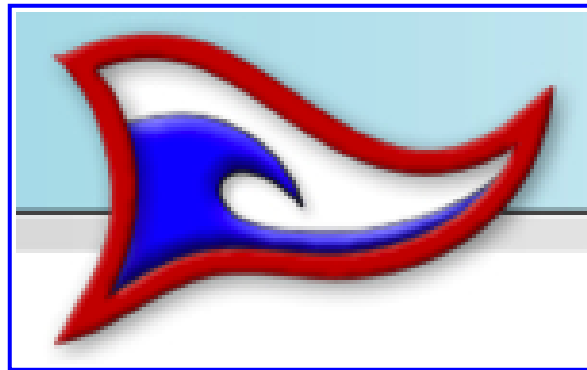

Our wine expert, Shelly Fitzgerald (who has led the tasting for the past 3-years), will be back again. We will be comparing wines from the same varietal or blend at two price points—about \$10 and \$25 –and seeing if we can tell the difference. We expect to have nine wines for tasting and a “welcome” wine when you arrive at 5pm.

We will ask the question, is the more expensive wine worth the price? We will also have wines that we call “wine steals and deals” with price points at \$6 or less! You will have the opportunity to order wines you like at case discount prices.

Please make your reservation by January 20th. All reservations are firm by that date (no cancellations) since we will have shopped for food and wine based on the number of reservations.
