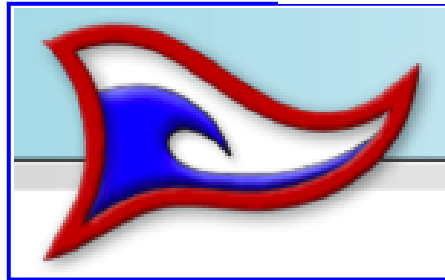


## Membership Report – Pat Hansen
