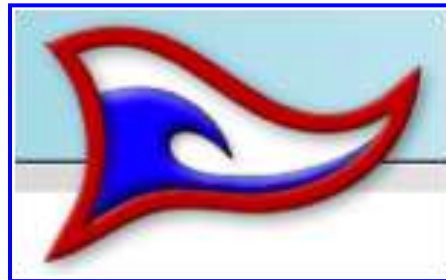
## Fleet Captain's Report – Robert Murphy
