Sunshine Report – Sharon Moore

I am delighted to report exceptional news that happened at our club. Rodney Jung volunteered his expertise time with the American Red Cross as a Disaster Health supervisor. Rodney was deployed to the Camp Fire in California and was assigned to a shelter in Oroville, California. Rodney's team consisted of 7 mental health professionals including 2 psychologists, 3 social workers, a mental health counselor and a psychiatric nurse (Rodney is a marriage and family therapist).

The majority of the shelter clients were there from the town of Paradise which before the fire had a population of approximately 27,000. They lost over 18,000 residences. At the beginning of the shelter, one of the most emotionally challenging issues was the search for the missing; later it became the confirmation of the fear that some had lost their homes and all their possessions.

At the last General Membership Meeting, October 17, 2018; it was unanimously decided to send the Happy Bucks money we collected (\$125.00) to the American Red Cross in honor of Rodney's help with survivors at the Camp Fire in California. I was overwhelmed with the kindness that our PSYC club shows in dire times of need.

I also was remiss in not honoring the many military veterans that are in our club. Veterans Day was November 11th and we are very thankful for all the men and women who are and have defended our freedom. I know that I was very happy to give Norm Grossmann a big kiss for all the sacrifices he made for America.

I also want to wish everyone a Very Merry Christmas and A Happy New Year. My wish for our club is that the future is bright and happy for everyone! The classic line from the movie It's A Wonderful Life is "Remember no man is a failure who has friends". Thanks for all the friendships!


