Commodore's Report – Adrienne Dahlin

I'd like to start off this month's report by congratulating our 2021-22 Trustees elect, Kelly Crowe, Sharon Moore, Robert Murphy, and David Morton and our 2021 Fleet Captain elect, Robert Dahlin. Thank you all for volunteering to serve the club in this way. I would also like to thank immediate Past Commodore Bill Traver and his committee member, PC/Trustee David Morton, for the work they did in securing nominees for the 2021 elections. Bill and David brought forward a wonderful slate of six amazing members for the four Trustee positions, which ensures we have two alternates should the need arise.

I am looking forward to serving as your Commodore again in 2021 and hope we will be able to gather in person at some point in the upcoming year (dare I dream of Opening Day festivities in May and group meals during summer cruises?). Plans that were understandably put on hold in 2020 must now move forward. I will be scheduling a virtual Past Commodore's meeting in

early 2021 and the Board will discuss re-establishing the critical Long-Range Planning work at our upcoming November Board meeting. The business of the club must go on!

On October 12th, I participated in our required annual meeting with representatives from Hat Island. Vice Commodore, Ted Gross and Trustee, Jerry Zitkovich attended the meeting with me. We primarily discussed the transfer of slips 10 and 11 back to Hat Island, which will occur on July 1, 2021. July 1st will be the date we transfer subsequent slips in the designated years. Hat Island did ask that we remind members to fly our PSYC burgee when arriving and staying in the marina. Also, be sure to file a float plan so they know you are coming. You may edit your float plan online should your plans change. Please see the Hat Island Update from Jerry Zitkovich on the next page.

Hat Island Update

On July 1, 2021 we will transfer slips 10 & 11 to Hat Island as per the July 2015 agreement. This will reduce our annual moorage bill to Hat by about \$1,400 per year. We will use our remaining slips 1-9 until July 1, 2026, and have access to 128' of Hat Island's docks on a daily basis if our slips 1-9 are full.

The use of the additional slips, if necessary, must be coordinated with the Harbormaster (Barb Conwell) and paid for by the individual member. We will continue to have our June Cruise and Golf Tournament with additional slips from Hat Island as needed.

Going forward we need to use our float plan reservation system to reserve our slips on a "first come first served" basis. This will allow you to see if there is room on our slips, and if not, you have the option of contacting Barb to get a Hat Island slip at your expense.

The next transfer phase will take place in July 2026 with slips 1-5 going to Hat. That will save about \$4,000 per year, and will provide up to 313' of additional Hat Is. dock space on an individual basis.

Also, please fly your PSYC burgee when visiting our docks at Hat. Sometimes non-member boats try to come in and use our docks. If you need a new burgee contact Sharon Moore.

hopefully facilitate a sing-a-long and a visit from Santa.


