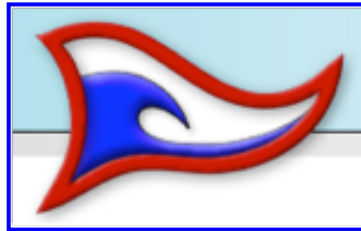
As we do want to make your cruising experience as fun, enjoyable and memorable as possible, your suggestions for activities while at port are extremely helpful!
