The Boat Show is quickly coming up starting on February 4<sup>th</sup>. We have all the shifts for our Booth filled except 11:00 to 2:00 and 2:00 to 5:00 on Wednesday, February 8<sup>th</sup>. If you can help, please let me know. For those of you who have signed up to work the Booth you can pick up your tickets at the Boat Show Office on the southwest corner of the second floor of the Lumen Field parking garage. A copy of the Assignment Sheet is included in this Month's Sound Waves. Please read the instructions regarding the use of the parking passes and the notice about requirements for Virus protection.

With David Morton's help we have finally been able to change all the locks on the

building and gates as well as the electrical panels so that we have one key for all the locks.

We now have a KnoxBox mounted on the outside of the building that the Fire Department can access to get the key for access to the building, dock, and electrical panels. If you have an old key, it will no longer work for any of the doors or gates. Please turn your keys in to Pat Hansen. If you have a key fob or card key, they will still work. If you need a key fob or key card, please contact David Morton or Pat Hansen.

### Project Status

Your PSYC Bridge is taking serious measures to maintain and protect our club, be proactive on issues that arise and add new items that will provide added security to our members and guests. Here is the list of ongoing and new projects and their status.

- **Installing a KnoxBox on front of Clubhouse so that the main power breaker can be padlocked. 100% Complete** This is completed. Special Thanks to David Morton for completing the rekeying of all doors

in the building. If you have keys to the front or rear doors, they will no longer work. Please contact David Morton to replace your old key with an electronic FOB that can be used to open the front door of the club. If you have a key to the gate, it will still work; however, we will soon be making that lock electronically controlled too.

- **Club PA System repair.** The board approved the purchase of replacement microphones and a receiver unit, which was purchased and now installed in the clubhouse. We continue to have issues with the amplifier and some of the wiring for the speakers. We hope to have this completely fixed by opening day.
- **Security upgrades to Clubhouse fence/gate.** This project is ongoing and will be added to the Spring work party task list. Additional addons may be added to further prevent the fence from being climbed over. More details to come at next edition of Sound Waves.
- **Security Camera Survey Completed.** This month I completed a security camera survey to determine the number of cameras required to cover our property, how to power them and how to connect them back to the recording unit in the clubhouse. This survey will be presented to the board for consideration and if approved will be added to Spring Work Party projects.

## Boat Show Schedule and Assignments

Instructions for Parking Passes --							
1.) The parking passes are good at the Safeco Field parking lot on the South side of Safeco Field on Edgar Martinez Way.							
2.) The passes are to be returned to the PSYC folder on the bulletin board each night.							
3.) The "starting crew" each morning should pick up both passes at the bulletin board at the Clubhouse							
4.) During the day you need to call someone on the schedule ahead of you when you get to the Exhibition Hall (on Occidental St.) and have one of the members bring out a pass from the booth. Then drive to the parking lot, showing the pass to get in, then bring the pass back with you to the booth, so you can hand it off to the next members manning the booth.							
5.) The last crew each night will take the parking passes and leave them at the Club in the envelope on the bulletin board.							
Everyone 12 and over will be required to provide proof of COVID-19 vaccination or present a negative Covid-19 test result taken within 72 hours. Masks are also required at all times except while actively eating or drinking, regardless of vaccination status.


