The snow, ice and freezing temps have created some challenges for us at the Clubhouse and dock; but nothing that a handful of truly incredible volunteers can't handle!

Special thanks to Bill and Kelly Crow for braving the elements and coming to the property to shovel snow off the walkways, along the side of the clubhouse and all the way to the end of the dock. Lastly, thank you David Morton, Jim White and others who helped with brushing snow off boat canvas and scattering enviro-friendly deicer on walkways to keep ice from accumulating.

This will require us to be continually vigilant of ice and snow buildup, icicles and ice that could fall from the roof and homeless activity as they look for warm places to reside. Here is the status of on-going projects at the club that are being taken care of by club volunteers:

- **Installing a KnoxBox on front of Clubhouse so that the main power breaker can be padlocked. 70% Complete** Waiting on final work to be done rekeying the clubhouse entrances.
- **Club PA System repair.** We are looking to replace the Microphone receiver and get two mics to go with it. The Board has approved the purchase of this replacement equipment and we hope to have to in place by January or February meeting.
- The repaired roof from November's roof leak held firm and is no longer leaking. Thank you, Jerry Zitkovich, for doing an amazing job patching up the ceiling on the on the second floor!
- **Security upgrades to Clubhouse fence/gate.** This project is still ongoing; however, the cold weather may delay this project even further.

Even though a lot of events got cancelled this past year, we still managed to pull off some great cruises and social events.


